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North Carolina non-public school law -- Article 39, Chapter 115C of the North Carolina General Statutes -- requires every non-public school to test its students utilizing a NATIONALLY standardized achievement test. For conventional nonpublic schools, this testing requirement pertains only to grade 3, 6, 9 and 11 students. Home schooled students are required to be tested every school year.

This publication features information such as test descriptions, ordering and administration policies and procedures for tests required of the North Carolina public schools. This program is known as the North Carolina Statewide Testing Program. Please note that these public school tests are not nationally standardized assessments as required by North Carolina non-public school law. Therefore, if you wish to voluntarily participate in the North Carolina Statewide Testing Program described in this publication, be aware that you will also incur additional testing expense in order to meet the non-public school laws of the State of North Carolina.
